

Town of South Windsor  
Veterans Memorial Park  
Monument Walk

In an effort to honor veterans of South Windsor, both past and present, the Patriotic Commission is soliciting funds to enhance the beauty and functionality of Veterans Memorial Park through the creation of a permanent brick sculpture. The sculpture will incorporate a patio type setting of an eagle with outstretched wings, at the head of a walkway into Veterans Memorial Park. Resident veterans, and families of veterans, may purchase bricks inscribed with the veteran's name, military branch, and years of service. Each brick can accommodate two lines of engraving consisting of 13 letters/spaces per line. The purchase of bricks is not limited to veterans. Any town resident or business may purchase a brick to show their patriotism and support for this project. The price per brick is \$35. Applications for brick purchases by, or in honor of, veterans, must be accompanied by verification of military service.

In addition to the sculpture and walkway, funds raised will be used to erect monuments dedicated to town residents lost in World War I, World War II, and the Korean War, to compliment the existing Viet Nam War monument.
