In accordance with Section 16a-32-6(d) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, I would like to notify you of the recent action taken by the Continuing Legislative Committee on State Planning and Development concerning your application for an interim change to the Conservation and Development Policies Plan for Connecticut, 2005-2010 (C&D Plan). The Continuing Committee met on November 9, 2009 and voted to approve Mr. Dustin Mitchell's application to change the designation for the approximately three acre parcel of land located at 96 Griffin Rd in East Windsor from a "Conservation" designation to a "Neighborhood Conservation" designation. The effective date of this change is December 2, 2009, which is when OPM was officially notified of the Committee's action.
