SUBJECT: 96 TUMBLEBROOK DRIVE

I am writing at the advice of Mr. Fred Shaw to request an accommodation from the Water Pollution Control Authority in regard to the property mentioned above. As I'm sure you know, the property is now in my name as ordered by the court in a 2008 judgment; it was previously owned by my former husband, Richard Shenkman. I am attempting to sell it to satisfy the debts he created over the last few years to encumber the property and I have a potential buyer. During inspection of the remaining foundation, it came to my attention that the septic tank had been crushed.

When I questioned the individual who cleared the debris from the property after the house burned down, he told me the tank was already crushed when he began his clean up work. The destruction apparently occurred when the burnt building was pushed into the confines of the foundation. The potential buyer of course is hesitant to complete the purchase because of the added expense of hooking up to the city sewer system. The purpose of this letter is to ask that the WPCA waive the permit and hook up fees for this property.

I realize this is an unusual request and I would not ordinarily ask for this accommodation but for the extreme financial condition I am in as a result of my former husband's actions. The town, through the actions of the police on July 7, 2009, has been very good to my family. Were it not for the forbearance and dedication of those who responded that day, our lives would have been in even more danger. I will always be grateful for the help and support we received. I am anxious to sell this property so my family and I can move on and so that we can repay some of my former husband's debts, including those he owes the town for several years of unpaid taxes.

I hope the WPCA will consider this request. Thank you very much.
