



# Town of South Windsor BONDED CAPITAL PROJECTS

## DEMING STREET WIDENING

### Project Description

Deming Street east of Buckland Road is narrow and has a steep hill with poor sight lines. This is a safety concern as motorists can not see on-coming traffic well in advance and do not have a lot of road width to use to avoid a collision. There is also a lack of adequate storm drainage that results in road flooding and icing.

### Recommended Solution

This section of road needs to be widened to standard Town Street width and the grade on the hill reduced to improve the sight line and overall safety. Drainage structures and pipes need to be installed along the hill to capture storm water. This project will require the relocation of several utilities.

### Schedule

Engineering	2007 - 2008
Easements/ROW	2008
Construction	Projected in 2008 or 2009 (depending on utility relocations)

### Status (as of 7/7/08)

The plans are about 70% complete and will be finished after the Town receives accurate locations of the water main under the road from The Connecticut Water Co.
