WORK PERFORMED:

Under the frequent supervision of the Plant Supervisor, or Facility Mechanic; basic functions involve the maintenance of plant and pump station grounds and equipment. May do errands in Town vehicles.

DETAIL DUTIES:

Will be expected to use appropriate compounds and tools for the maintenance of grounds and equipment at the plant and the pump stations. Will assist personnel of a higher classification in the maintenance and operation of the pollution control equipment, as directed.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILL, AND ABILITY:

Basic mechanical aptitude. Ability to use a variety of hand and power tools and equipment; and to apply common sense understanding to carry out detailed, but uninvolved, written or oral instructions. Make arithmetical calculations involving fractions, decimals, and percentages. Considerable physical strength and stamina.

EXPERIENCE AND TRAINING:

High school graduate or trade school graduate; or equivalent training. Vocational or high school shop courses; or equivalent on-the-job training desirable. No experience required.

SPECIAL PROVISION:
